The Foundation's assets are over \$2.5 million and it wouldn't be possible without the support of all the donations made over the years.

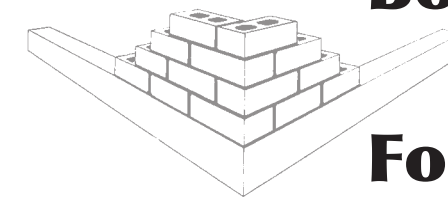
"For our size of a community it is a huge accomplishment and reflects the support we have received now and over the years that the Foundation has been active" said Arde.

The Foundation wants more than the grant recipients on hand for the cheque presentation. Arde stressed the board's desire to have Town of Boissevain and RM of Morton residents, business owners, past board members and people wanting to know more about the Foundation in attendance.

The Foundation will be granting a total of \$87,000, of which approximately \$35,000 will go to projects selected by an application process and the board's consideration.
