

We have met the Thomas Sill Challenge

With the generosity of all who have participated, the Boissevain Morton Foundation has raised over \$50,000 since March 2015 and will now receive a donation of \$25,000 from the Thomas Sill Foundation.

Wonderful surprise

The late Jacob D. Dyck has left a beguest of \$119,000 to the Boissevain Morton Foundation, adding to the \$150,000 bequest received last year. This now brings the total of the bequest in memory of Jacob D. Dyck to \$269,000.
