- projects supported may change over time, depending on the needs of the community



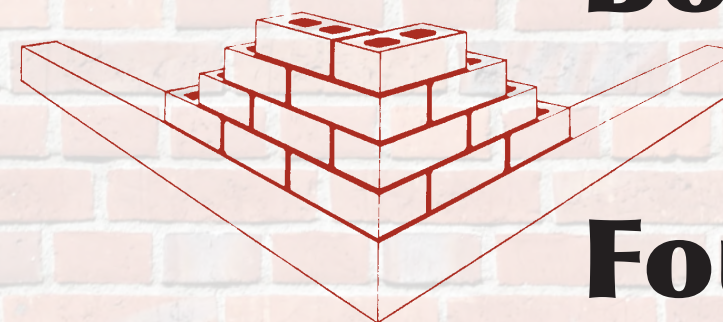
**Boissevain & Morton Foundation received**

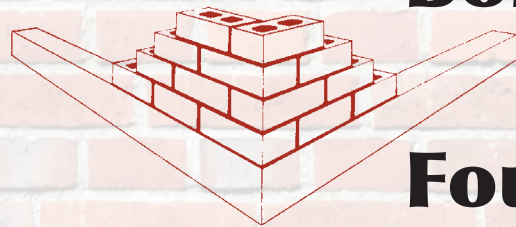
## Youth in Philanthropy
