We are a gracious recipient of one of these yearly grants. For the 2025 granting year the board has made the decision to include this grant money into our undesignated grant pool.

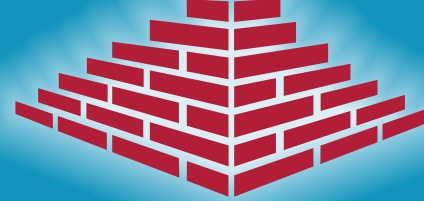
We will present the Thomas Sill Manitoba Fund Grant at our granting evening in November.
